


'Horticulture Therapy Training'@ Coimbatore

The Department of Floriculture and Landscape Architecture, Horticultural College and Research Institute of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore organized a first-of-its-kind training program on 'Horticulture Therapy for visually impaired college students' in collaboration with the 'Help The Blind Foundation' on the 17th of August 2022. This program was organized at the recently renovated Botanical Garden of the University.

This training aimed at sensitizing the significance and potentiality of floriculture and gardening based horticulture therapy in improving the overall wellness of people with special needs. The training was imparted to 25 trainees from 10.30 am to 6.00 pm. The training program was organized with technical guidance of the Professor and Head of the Department of Floriculture and Landscape Architecture, Dr. K. Rajamani in the presence of the Dean (Hort.) of HC & RI, TNAU, Coimbatore, Dr. P. Irene Vethamoni.





The organizer of the training program, Dr. M. Ganga, Professor (Horticulture) of the Department of Floriculture and Landscape Architecture coordinated the conduct of the training with the Project Officer (All India) of HTBF, Mrs. Ambika Seetharaman. Faculty members of the Department of Floriculture and Landscape Architecture, Dr. M. Velmurugan and Dr. S. Karthikeyan, Assistant (Professors of Horticulture) and M.Sc. and Ph.D. scholars of the department imparted hands-on-training on various horticulture therapy activities.

The trainees were imparted with the skills of identifying various fragrant flowers and aromatic plants based on olfactory (sense of smell) and somatosensory (sense of touch) stimuli. They were also imparted with the skills of identifying and differentiating various textures prevalent in leaves and seeds of flower and ornamental plants such as smoothness, roughness, glossiness, pubescence, etc. using somatosensory stimuli. They were engaged in simple gardening activities including filling up of polybags with growing media and sowing of seeds. They were also sensitized on the various entrepreneurial avenues open to them in the floriculture sector.
