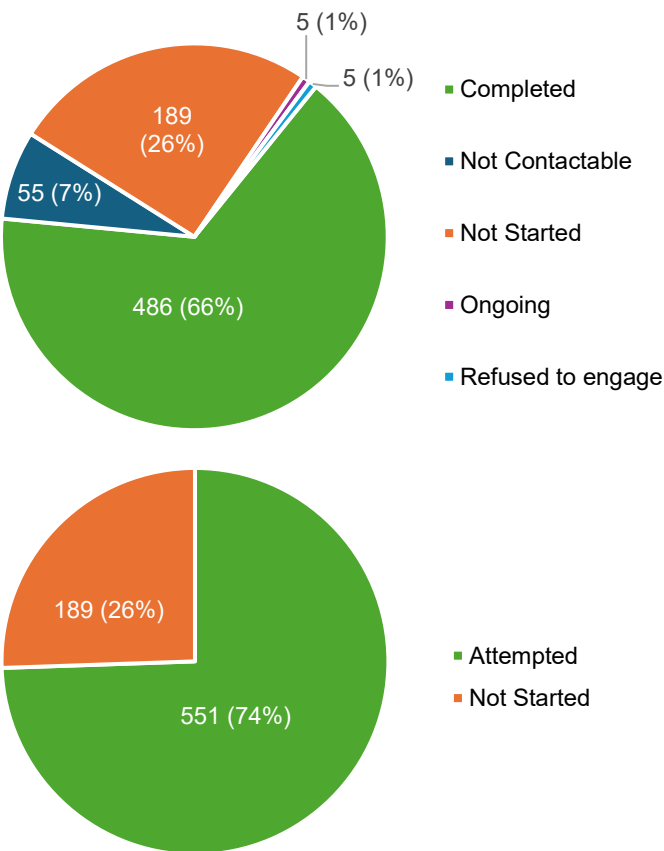

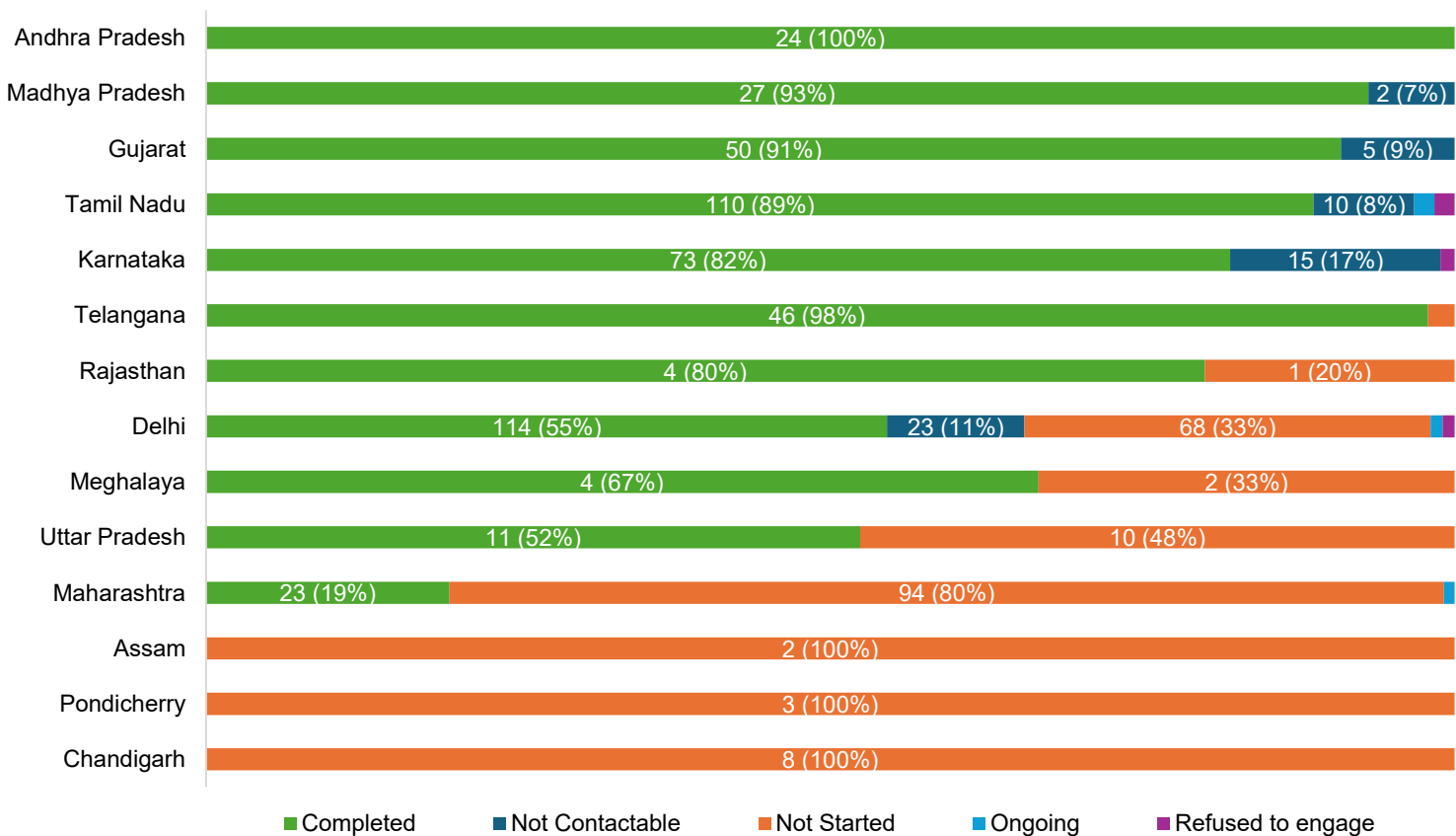
# Survey Exercise Progress

## Overall Survey Completion Status



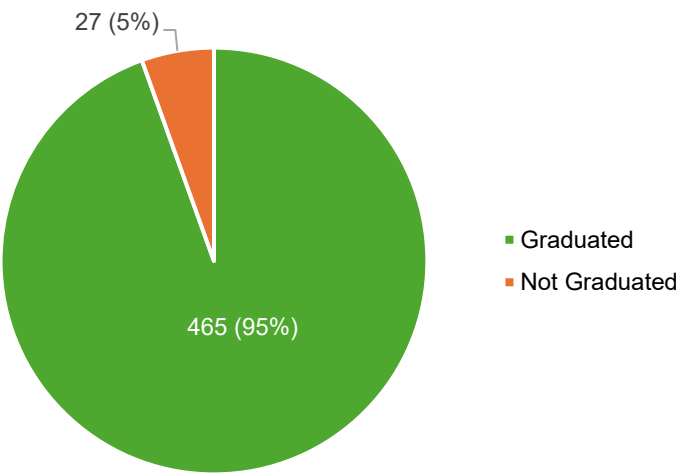
## Survey Completion Status by State



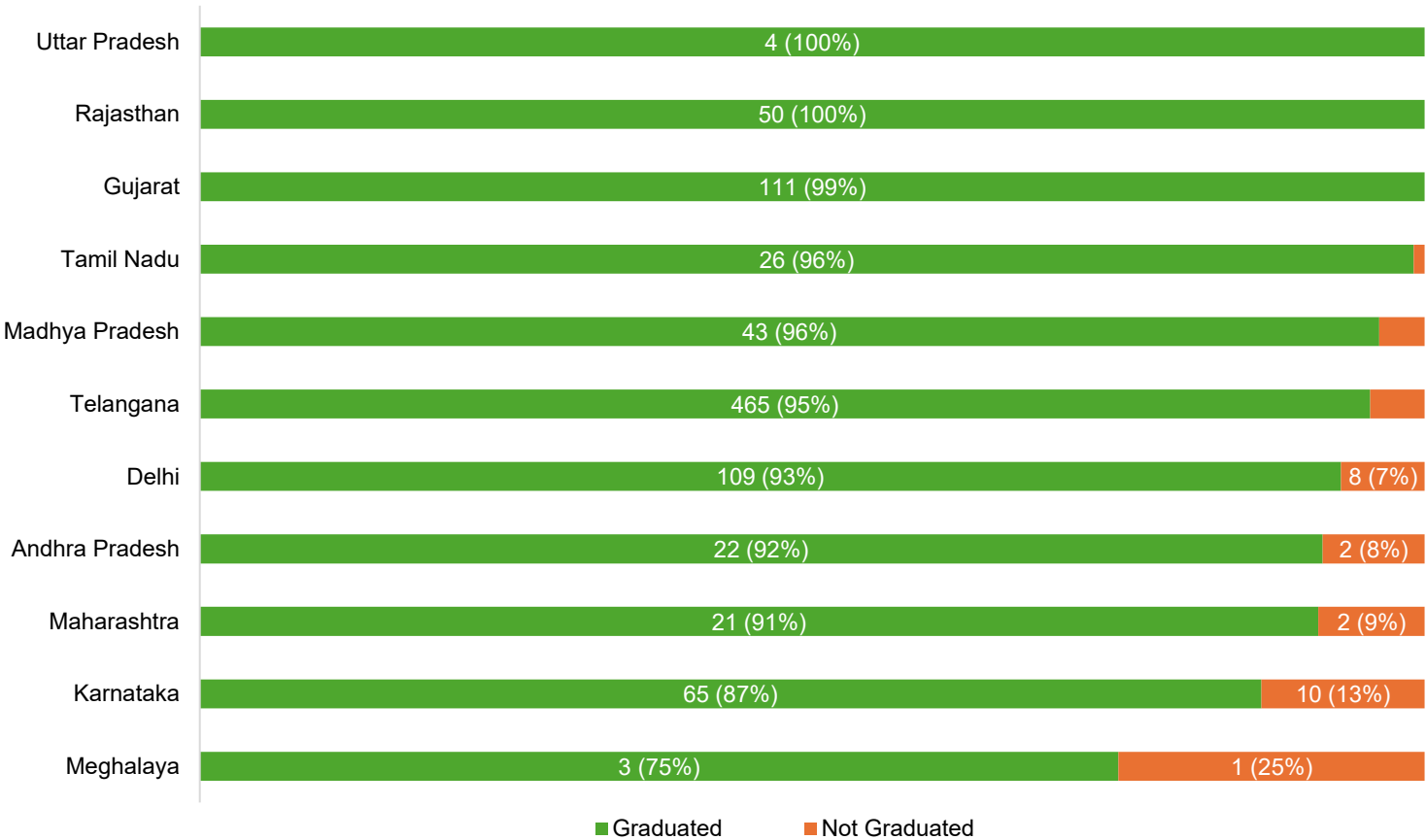
# Graduation Rates

Graduation Rates by State

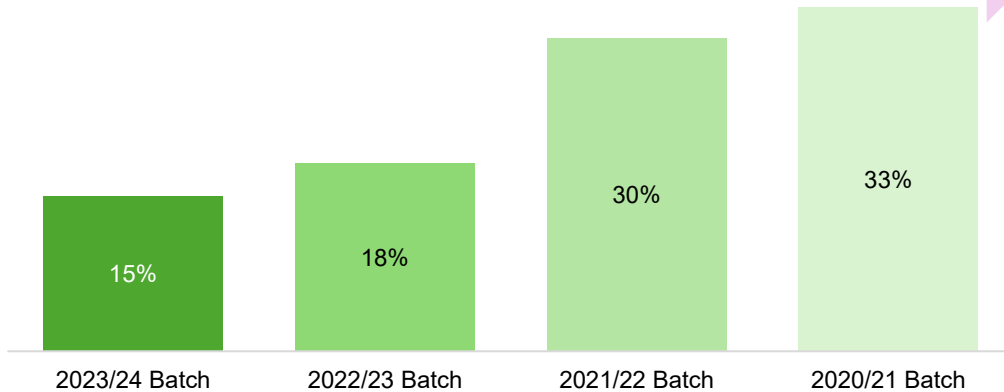


# Deep-Dive on Employed Students

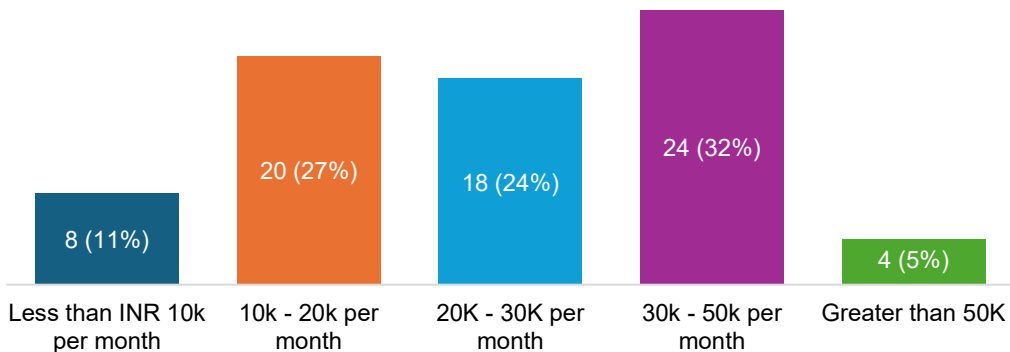
Private sector's employment share showed promising growth to 38% of the total, with 37% of students in the batch securing salary packages of > INR 30,000 per month

## Employment Percentages by Batches Surveyed

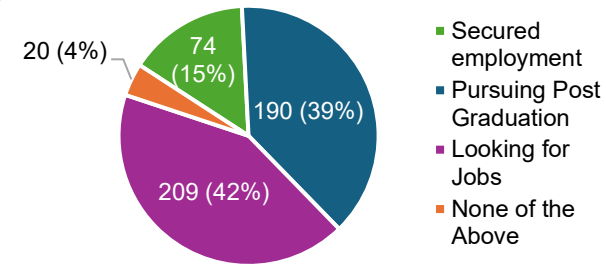
Employment % increases with amount of time spent in the job market



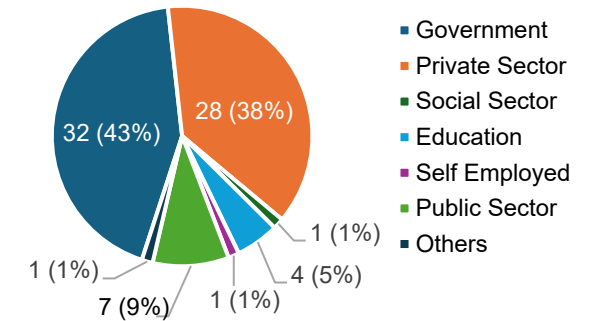
## Salaries of Students Who Secured Employment



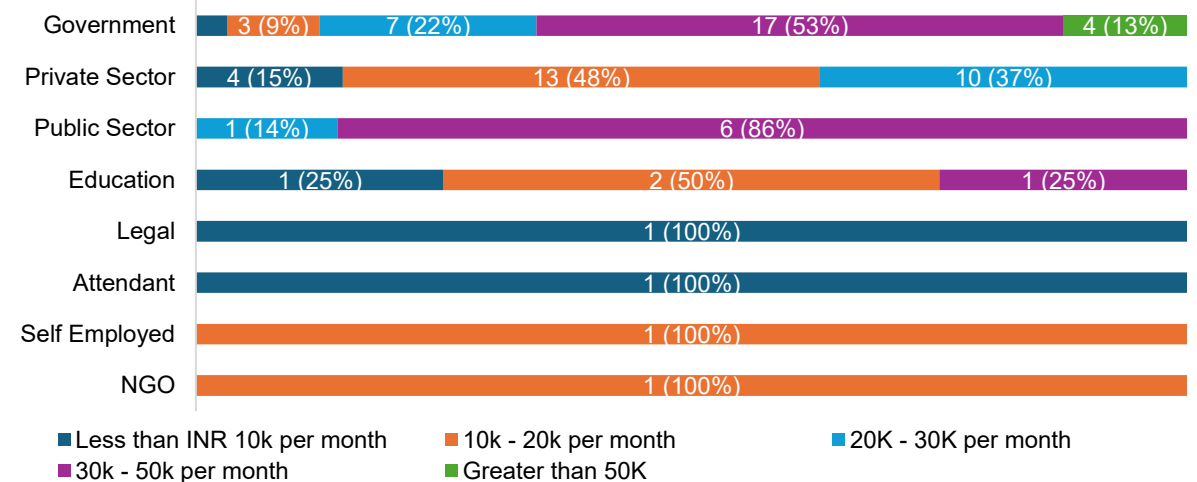
## Student Status After Graduation



## Employment by Sector



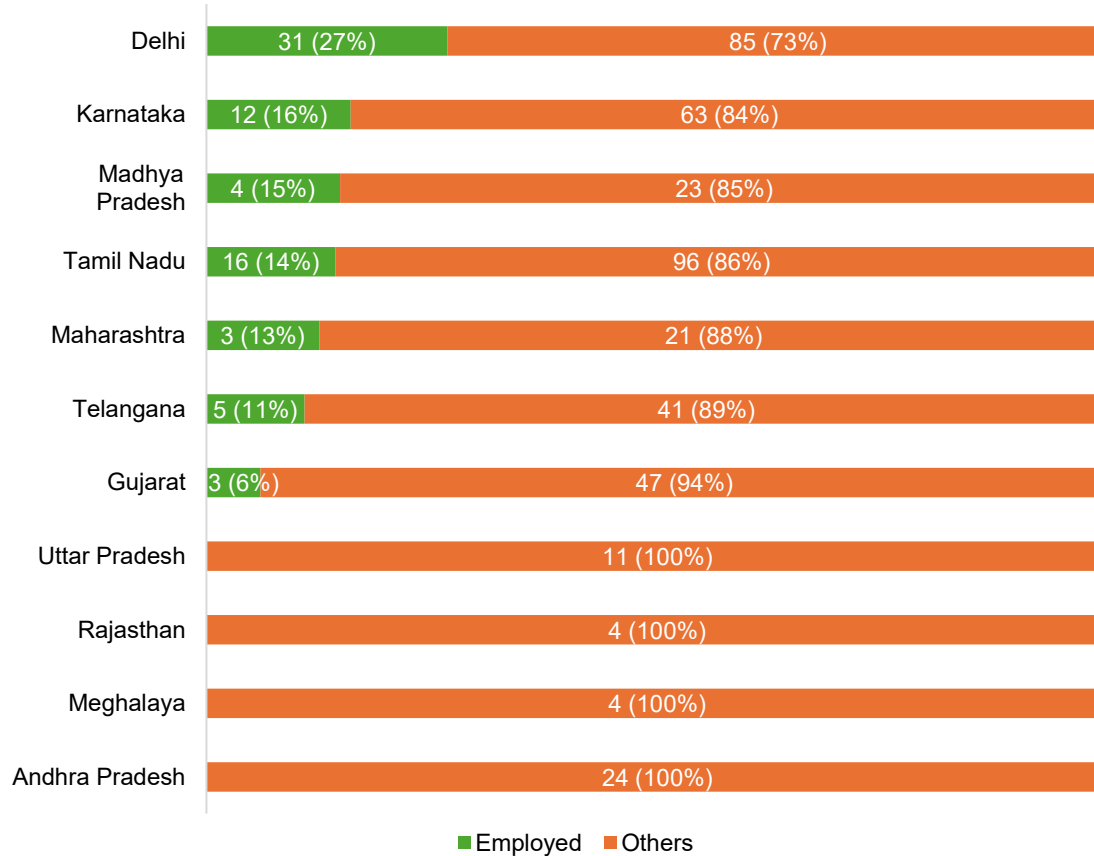
## Salary Ranges by Employment Sector



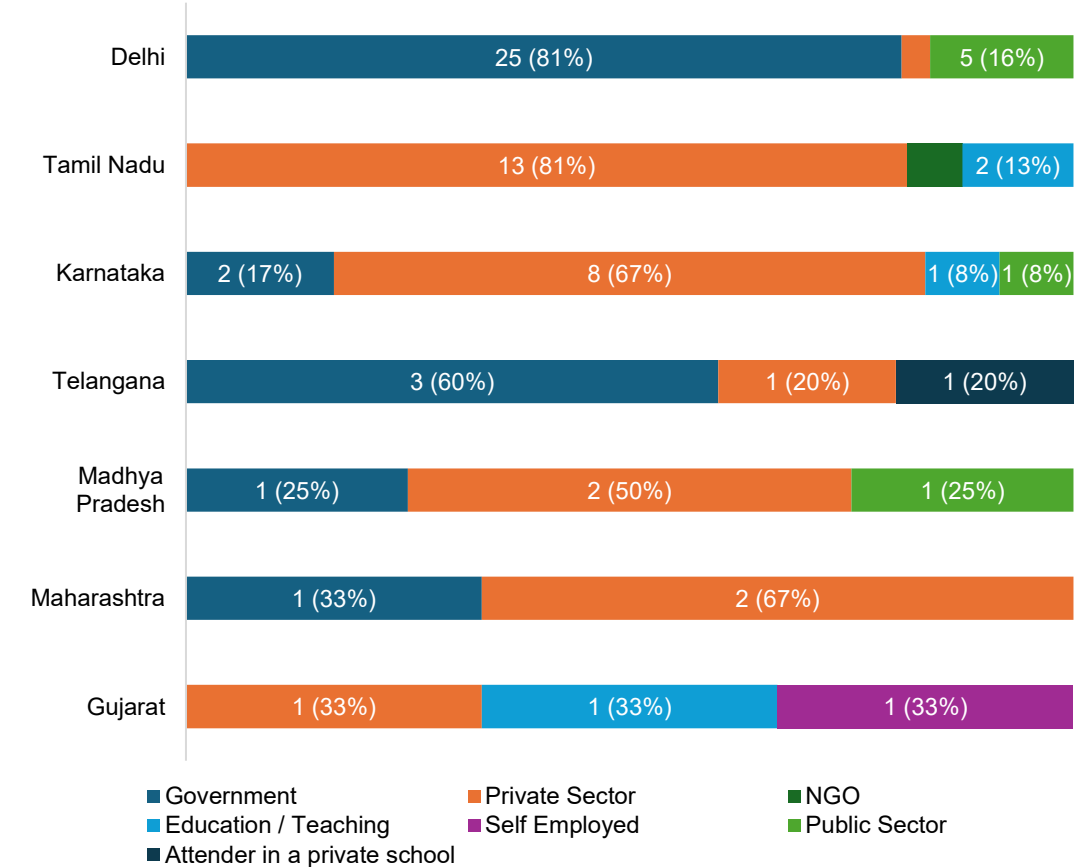
# Employment Status by State

## Employment by State



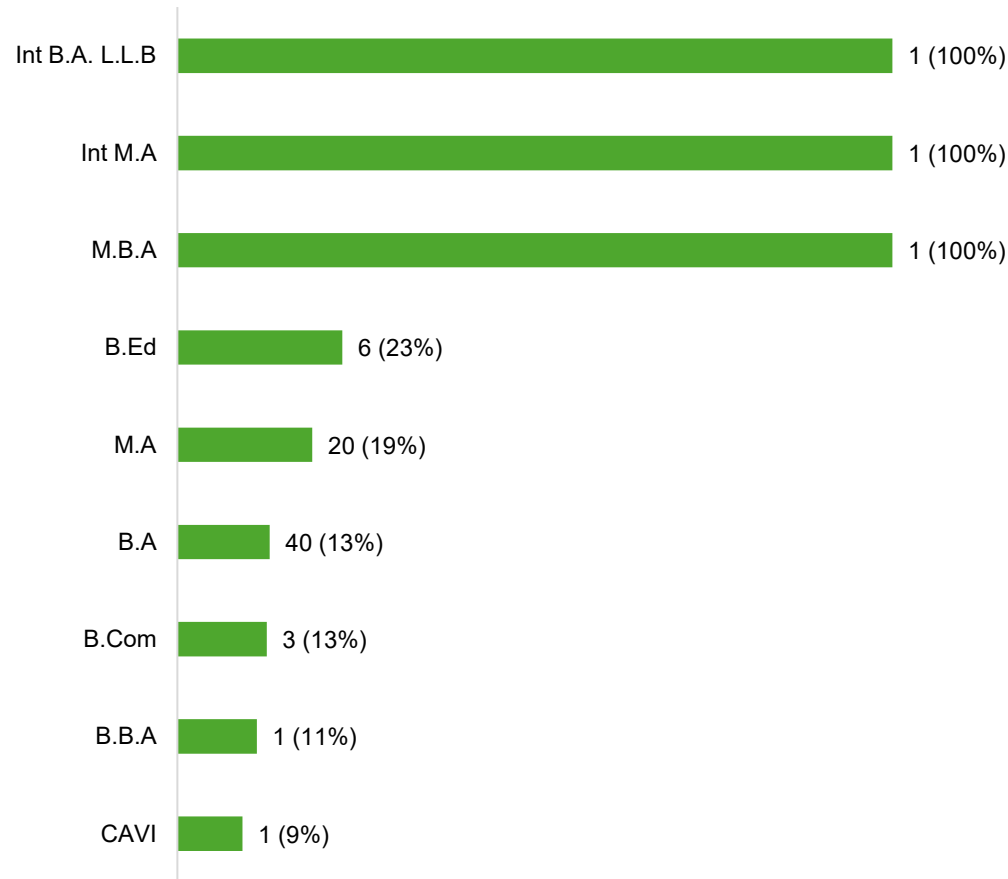
## Sectors in Which Students Have Secured Employment in Each State



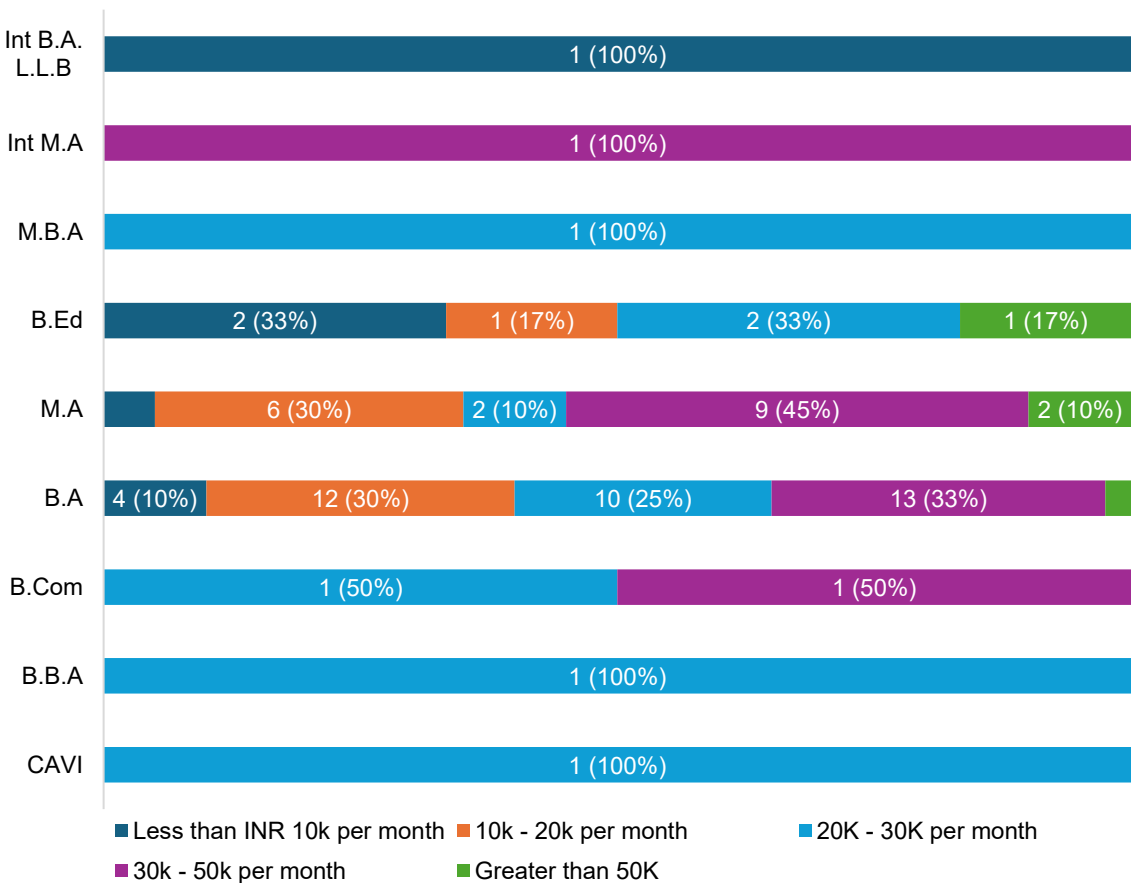
# Employment by Degrees Pursued

Employment Rates by Degree Pursued



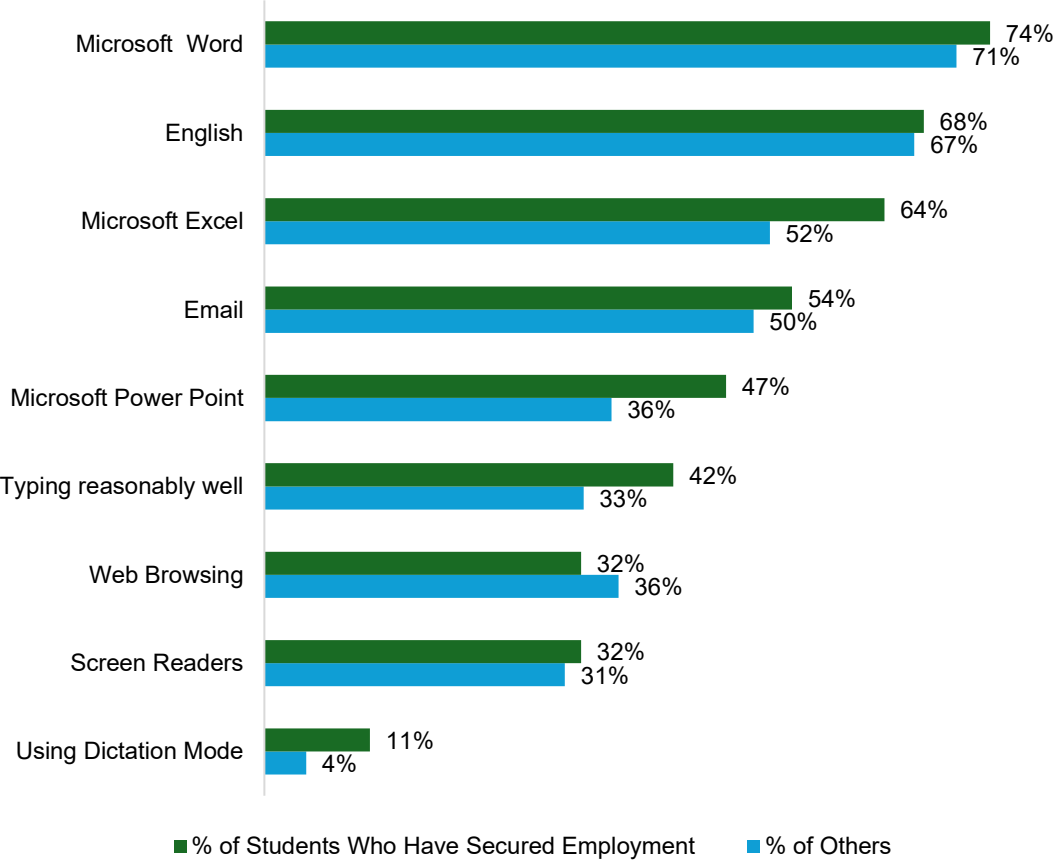
Salary Ranges by Degree Pursued



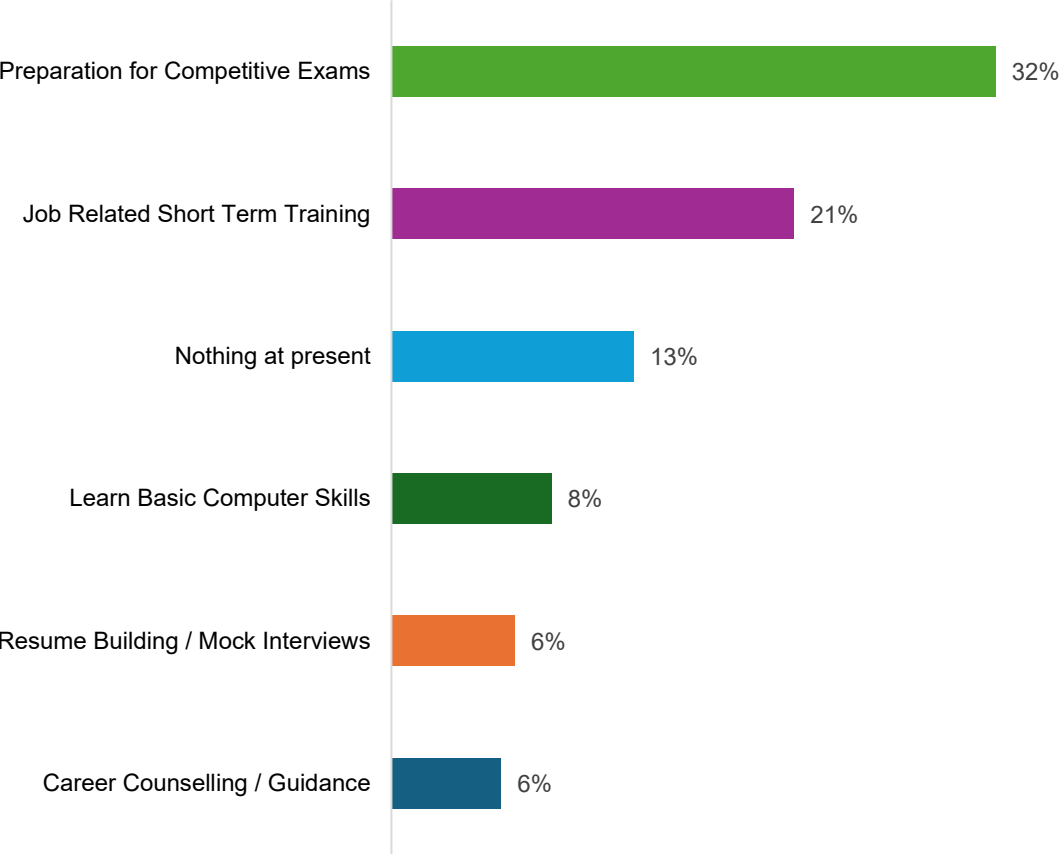
# Skills & Additional Assistance Sought
